They're a queer people in Islandmagee ...they're as queer a people as you'd find in the length and breadth of the land.'

A one act play written in 1948 based on the real witch trials that took place in Islandmagee in the early 1700's. Set over the course of an evening we follow Justice of the Peace Andrew Ferguson's investigation into Mary Dunbar's allegations that some local women had bewitched her.




